Notes from our Nurse:

*If your family could use a little extra support, you can request that your child receive a weekend food bag through our school's backpack program. Simply pick up the permission slip from the front office or Nurse Mendy, fill it out, and return it to us. Each Friday, students with completed forms will quietly receive a bag filled with nutritious, easy-to-prepare items to help stretch meals through the weekend. If you have any questions or need assistance, please don't hesitate to reach out.

Here is a review of the WCV Health Policy:

FEVER: Students must be fever free [without medication] for 24 hours before returning to school. A fever is 100.3 F or above.

HAND FOOT & MOUTH: If there is oozing from the wounds or if they have a fever, they are not to be at school. It can take up to 7 days for this to heal well enough for them to come to school.

VOMITING: Students must NOT have vomited for 24 hours before returning to school.

PINK EYE: Students can return to school once prescription eye drops have been started.

STREP THROAT: Students must have an antibiotic for at least 24 hours before returning to school.

COUGH/COLD: Students can remain at school with mild cough/cold symptoms. If the cough is continual, or becoming a distraction in class, the nurse will be consulted. If your child is going to require multiple cough drops throughout the day, please send them to school with your student. Your student's classroom teacher can keep them on their desk.

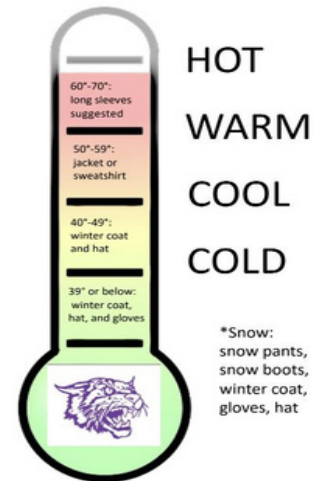
Weather Reminder
